

## **'Dr Andi' Horvath**

While tampering with pregnant sheep for a PhD, conducting university tutorials and discussing her work at parties, Dr Andi discovered that having dialogue with people about science in society was challenging and compelling. She has been dialoguing since.

After a stint with the Shell Questacon Science Circus, then as manager of the Victorian CSIRO Science Education Centre, she became involved in public science broadcasting on 3RRR's Einstein a Go Go. Dr Andi has lectured to future primary school teachers (Monash), taught History and Philosophy of Science (Melbourne) and worked on projects with SBS Television, ABC Radio and Channel 31. During Science week you'll often find her conducting dinner entertainment game called "Bright Sparks or doing a spot of public speaking.

Upon establishment of Museum Victoria, she was appointed Head Curator for the Human Mind and Body gallery, and currently works in the Museum's Science Communication Unit. Exhibitions include "Medical Melbourne" and "House Secrets". Dr Andi shares her thinking skills and practice of science communication in seminars called Science gym: public speaking for science types.
